

ANATOMAGE TEACHER AWARDS OFFICIAL RULES

1. Eligibility: The 2026 Anatomage Teacher Awards is open to candidates who: teach science in a public, private or charter school at the High school, Undergraduate or Graduate/Post-graduate levels in the United States and who use an Anatomage product as part of their curriculum. One (1) winner will be chosen for each award category: Outstanding Teacher Award - High School, Outstanding Teacher Award - Undergraduate, Outstanding Teacher Award - Graduate/Postgraduate, Trailblazer Award. Employees of Anatomage, its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and suppliers, (collectively the “Employees”), and immediate family members and/or those living in the same household of Employees are not eligible to participate in the Awards program. The Award is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited.

2. Being selected as a winner does not constitute an endorsement from Anatomage.

3. Entry Period: The award application period will open on June 1, 2026. The award application period closes on June 30, 2026. Award recipients will be notified from July 10-13, 2026. The winners award presentation will happen at the 2026 Anatomage Conference from July 23-24, 2026.

4. Agreement to Rules: By participating, the Contestant (“You”) agrees to be fully unconditionally bound by these Rules, and You represent and warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements. In addition, You agree to accept the decisions of Anatomage as final and binding as it relates to the content of this Award.

5. How to Apply: All applications must be submitted online at anatomage.com/teacher-awards and must be received no later than 11:59 PM Pacific time on Tuesday, June 30, 2026, in order to be considered. This includes submitting the following: Completed application form and a written response to the following questions:

- Outstanding Teacher Award
 - How do you inspire your students to study anatomy and physiology/science? How has your teaching made a difference in the lives of your students?
 - What does success look like for your students and your program? Include evidence, such as data, stories, or anecdotes, to support your response.
- Trailblazer Award
 - How have you used Anatomage technology in a unique or unconventional way to support student learning or engagement?
 - What outcomes or changes have you observed as a result of this innovative approach? Provide examples or stories that highlight its impact.

Up to 2 additional materials may be included to support your application (photos, video, link, etc.). Entrants must be at least 18 years of age or older to participate, or the age of majority in

their state, as required by law.

6. Limitations on Entries: You may enter only once for each award category. You must provide the information requested. You may not enter more times for the same category than indicated by using multiple email addresses or identities. If You use fraudulent methods or otherwise attempt to circumvent the rules, your entry may be removed from eligibility at the sole discretion of Anatomage.

7. Award Conditions: There will be one (1) cash prize for each of the following award categories: Outstanding Teacher Award - High School, Outstanding Teacher Award - Undergraduate, Outstanding Teacher Award - Graduate/Postgraduate, Trailblazer Award. The Winners agree to participate in media interviews and filming during their participation at the Anatomage Conference. The Winner must provide Anatomage with a valid Social Security number or taxpayer identification number before the prize will be awarded. A form 1099 will be issued to each winner. Acceptance of prize money constitutes permission for Anatomage to use Winner's name, likeness, and entry for purposes of advertising and trade without further compensation, including participation in video interviews, unless prohibited by law.

8. Odds: The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

9. Winner Selection and Notification: On or around July 1, 2026 through July 8, 2026, an Anatomage judging panel will review all eligible entries received throughout the award period to select one (1) winner in each category. The (4) winners will be notified via email before or on July 10, 2026. Anatomage shall have no liability for Winner's failure to receive notices due to spam, junk email, or other security settings or for Winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information. If Winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the response within 5 days from the time award notification was sent, or fails to timely return a completed and executed declaration and release as required, the prize may be forfeit and an alternate Winner selected. Receipt by Winners of the prize offered in this Award is conditioned upon compliance with any and all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY WINNER (AT ANATOMAGE SOLE DISCRETION) WILL RESULT IN WINNER'S DISQUALIFICATION AS WINNER OF THE AWARD, AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.

10. Rights Granted by You: By entering, You understand and agree that Anatomage, anyone acting on behalf of Anatomage, and Anatomage licensees, successors, and assigns, shall have the right, where permitted by law, to print, publish, broadcast, distribute, and use in any media now known or hereafter developed, in perpetuity and throughout the World, without limitation, your entry, name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, image, statements about the Award, and biographical information for news, publicity, information, trade, advertising, public relations, and promotional purposes without any further compensation, notice, review, or consent.

11. Terms & Conditions: Anatomage reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any

individual who tampers or attempts to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Awards or violates these Terms & Conditions.

12. Limitation of Liability: By entering, You agree to release and hold harmless Anatomage and its subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, partners, representatives, agents, successors, assigns, employees, officers, and directors from any liability, illness, injury, death, loss, litigation, claim, or damage that may occur, directly or indirectly, whether caused by negligence or not, from: (i) such entrant's participation in the Awards and/or his/her/their acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize or any portion thereof.

13. Agreement to Rules: By participating, the Contestant ("You") agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these Rules, and You represent and warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances shall participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waives all rights to, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including reasonable attorney's fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (i.e., costs associated with entering this Award). Participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
